**Safety** Please remind your visitors AND others you see, to remain behind the pipe line, unless invited by a pilot, who is escorting them! And do not taxi from the starting pads if anyone is on a pilot station in front of you flying.

Membership card holders are available from several of the club officers, so ask for one the next time you see them. CURRENT cards area to be displayed when flying.

Also, there has been a lot of confusion lately on flying the pãttern ðhen there is a group at the field. The take off pattern varies with the wind. The flying pattern is also based on the wind. If take off is to the South, the pattern is counter-clock wise; and it to the North its clock wise. The concern is when five pilots are up, two going left, two going right, and one guy in the middle just flying any where. That s how accidents happen. So please, watch the pattern and when heavy, have a spotter!!!

**ALL are urged to re-read the field flight and safety rules for the flying field!**

Remember, each year you renew your membership; the statement at the bottom says you have read the AMA and club by-laws. The By-laws may be read on the NEW club website!
