Our intrepid flyer however, chose to take off to the North – in the opposite direction of traffic. When asked about it, he had no idea of what he had done or of the club policy. This is how accidents happen.

Remember, each year you renew your membership, you sign a statement that you have read and will comply with the AMA and club by-laws. The by-laws contain our club's safety requirements. They are also available for you to read on the NEW club website! If you are getting a little "fuzzy" on the rules, you are urged to re-read them prior to you next visit to the flying field.

We are continuing emphasis on flying the "pattern" when there is a group at the field. Of course, the direction of take off is based on wind direction. If take off is to the South, the pattern is counter-clock wise. Take off to the North and the pattern is clockwise. Gee, which way do I take off if the wind is calm?? (*See above for answer).

The concern is when five pilots are up, two going left, two going right, and one guy in the middle just flying any where. That's how accidents happen. So please, watch the pattern and when heavy, have a spotter!!!

Please remind your visitors AND others you see, to remain behind the pipe line, unless invited by a pilot, who is escorting them! And do not taxi from the starting pads if anyone is on a pilot station in front of you flying.
