Airbus Cockpit Picture

This is the first picture I've seen of the cockpit of the new A380 Airbus. Thought you all would enjoy.



Note the keyboard and the computer screen and the flight control "stick". Also note the almost total absence of levers and switches (mostly buttons only – it is a flying laptop).

Save the picture to your desk top and blow it up. You can see the location of the aircraft by looking at the GPS (yes, that's France) on the ECIS (or Engine Indications and Crew Alerting System) and also on the split screen you can see a view of the aircraft from the tail camera view and under the aircraft looking at the nose wheel. This is to assist during taxi and landing.

Safety –

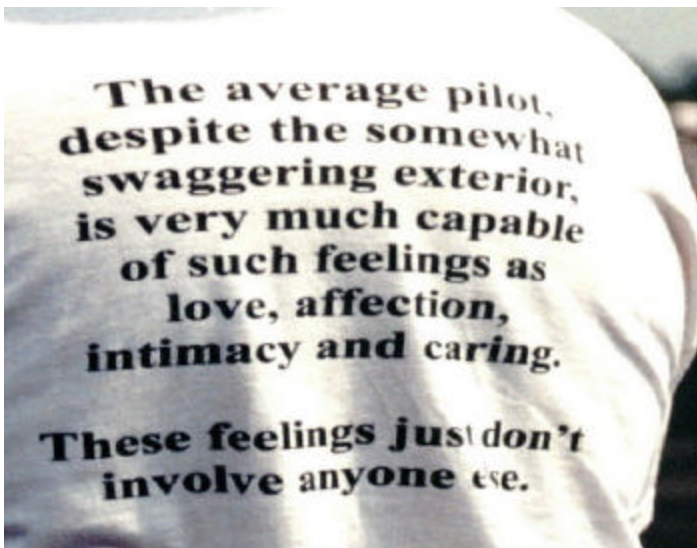
